(21-09-95) Motion Cr. Greer that the minutes from the August 3rd meeting be adopted as presented. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

(21-09-96) Motion Cr. Drummond to adopt the agenda with the additions. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

(21-09-97) Motion Cr. Drummond to accept the tender submitted by 4099982 Canada Inc. operating as Kelly Brothers Equipment Rentals for winter road maintenance for the 2021-2022 season consisting of 81.77 k.m. North of Route 148 in the amount of \$2615.68 per k.m., taxes included. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.
