PUBLIC NOTICE

**TO THOSE INTERESTED IN THE SECOND DRAFT RESOLUTION 18-08-87  
ADOPTED IN VIRTUE OF BY-LAW # 305 (SCAOP1) RELATIVE TO AN  
IMMOVEABLE LOCATED AT 19 Ninth Line HAVING THE RIGHT TO  
PARTICIPATE IN A REFERENDUM**

PUBLIC NOTICE is given, to interested persons and organizations:

**1. PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT AND REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN A REFERENDUM**

Following the Public Consultation held on July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018, Council adopted, on August 7<sup>th</sup> 2018, second draft resolution #18-08-87 entitled “Draft Resolution #18-08-87 relative to an authorisation request under the provisions of By-Law # 305 concerning Specific Construction, Alteration or Occupancy Proposals of an Immoveable (SCAOP1).”

The qualified voters entitled to be registered on the referendum list of the municipality may request that resolution #18-08-87 be subject to a referendum by entering their name, address and capacity and signing in a register provided for this purpose.

This resolution project aims to authorize the following elements, which are not in conformity with Zoning By-Law # 312:

- a. Construction of 2 to 4 basic shelters with an area of 30 m<sup>2</sup>;
- b. Allowing Class C2 usage for agritourism;
- c. Allowing Class C1 use for accommodations with a maximum of 5 bedrooms for rental purposes.

This draft resolution contains provisions that may be the subject of an application by the interested persons in order that a resolution containing these provisions is subject to approval in accordance with the Law on Elections and Referendums in Municipalities.

Therefore, an application for a provision relating to a point mentioned above can originate from the implicated Zone AG-108 and contiguous Zones AG-104, AG-105, AG-107, AG-109, AG-112 and AG-113.

**2. CONDITIONS FOR A VALID REQUEST**

To be valid, a request must:

- Clearly indicate the provision to which it relates and the zone from which it originates;
- Be received at the Municipal Office at 32 Aylmer Road, by August 20th, 2018, at 4:00 p.m.;
- Be signed by at least 12 interested persons of one of the zones from where they originate or by at least the majority of them if the number of interested persons in the area does not exceed 21.

### 3. INTERESTED PERSONS

3.1. Any persons who, on August 7th, 2018, is not disqualified from voting under Article 524 of the Law on Elections and Referendums in Municipalities and fulfills the following conditions:

- Be a natural person, residing within the municipality, and has been domiciled for at least six (6) months in Quebec;
- Be at least 18 years of age, of Canadian Citizenship and not be under guardianship;

3.2. Any non resident sole owner of an immovable or non resident sole occupant of a business establishment who is not disqualified from voting and fulfills the following conditions:

- Be the owner of an immovable or occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
- In the case of a natural person, be at least 18 years of age, of Canadian citizenship and not be under guardianship.

3.3. Any non resident sole owner of an immovable or non resident sole occupant of a business establishment who is not disqualified from voting and fulfills the following conditions:

- Be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
- Be designated, by means of a proxy signed by the majority of people who are co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, as the one who has the right to sign the register in their name and to be registered on the referendum list, if that is the case. This power of attorney must have been produced prior to or at the signing of the register.

### 3.4. Legal Person

- Be designated by resolution, among its members, directors or employees, a person who, on August 7th, 2018, and at the moment of exercising this right, is of age and a Canadian citizen, who is not under guardianship and is not in any incapacity to vote under the law.

### 4. CONSULTATION OF THE PROJECT

The resolution project and map of the designated area can be consulted at the Municipal Office, 32 Aylmer Road, Bristol, during regular office hours.
