In addition to creating habitats for a diversity of species such as the **Blanding's turtle**, a species at risk, these wetlands offer invaluable services for the human and to compensate for the hazards of Mother Nature. Wetlands are like the kidneys of our environment: they filter water and kill pathogens, but also regulate water flow during floods and retain a large amount of sediment.



Did you know? The approximate value of wetland services is estimated at \$478/ha per year! This value represents the costs associated with setting up a structure that would offer the same type of service. Luckily, wetlands are the result of free labors!
