



## HOME SELF INSPECTIONS

The Fire Safety Cover Plan of the Pontiac MRC which was adopted by the Municipality of Bristol requires that all buildings be inspected by the Fire Safety Service to verify that the smoke alarms of the buildings are:

- ✓ Located in the proper place. There must be one alarm per floor;
- ✓ In working order;
- ✓ Not expired. A smoke alarm has an expiration date of 10 years after its date of manufacture.

During your absence, a member of your Fire Safety Service was at your dwelling to complete the inspection. Since you were absent, we ask that you either phone the municipality at (819) 647-5555 to make an appointment or fill out the information contained in this document and return the document to the municipality either in person or by e-mail at: [info@bristolmunicipality.qc.ca](mailto:info@bristolmunicipality.qc.ca). Please be advised that even if you choose the self inspection option as opposed to scheduling an appointment that a member of the Fire Safety Service could potentially show up to perform the inspection, since all urbanized areas are subject to on-site inspections.
