TAX BILLS

Please be advised that the municipality will no longer be sending tax bills directly to the specified financial institutions. It is now your responsibility to ensure that your tax bill is forwarded for payment.

FINES

The municipality will continue to issue fines in accordance with by-law infractions. Consult the website under the *By-Laws* tab to ensure that you are in conformity or contact the office.

BUILDING PERMITS

Building permits are required for all major renovations. Before starting any renovation project, contact the Building Inspector, Marjorie Groulx-Tellier for proper information and procedures. Any unauthorized construction is liable to an infraction.

ACCESS WAYS

Municipal access ways are to be kept clear at all times in order that they are accessible for the Fire Department. The storage of any type of items could lead to their removal by the municipality at your expense. Parking is prohibited in the access ways at ALL times and will be liable to an infraction of \$75.00 plus fees.

SPRING CLEAN-UP

The "Let's Keep Bristol Beautiful" Campaign will continue. Assist those striving to beautify our municipality by considering adopting a road and picking up the trash.

BURN PERMITS

Burn permits for burning brush are issued between November 1st & April 30th, subject to weather conditions, at no charge.

To obtain a permit, contact the municipal office. It is prohibited to burn building materials.

DOG AND CAT LICENSES

Dog and cat licenses are **renewable yearly** and expire on December 31st. These tags are available at the Municipal Office at a cost of \$20.00. Dogs on public property must be on a leash at **ALL TIMES**.

TRANSFER STATION

For those with **Summer** garbage collection, the municipality is now **requesting** that **clear** garbage bags be used for the disposal of **both recycling and waste.**

COMPOSTERS

Composters are still available for sale at the municipal office at a cost of \$50.

SNOW REMOVAL

It is forbidden to push snow across the street, or into the street when clearing your driveway.
